



An introduction to Beekeeping with Stowmarket Beekeepers 2018

If you are interested in becoming a beekeeper and live in the Stowmarket area then this is definitely the course for you

Our expert beekeepers will take you through the basic understanding of bees and beekeeping and introduce you to the skills and equipment you will need to get started.

We start with two evening courses with presentations, discussions and a chance for you to ask as many questions as you would like. We will provide you with a free copy of one of the top beekeeping handbooks to take away from the course, and on completion of the course we will assist you in getting your first colony of bees if you wish.
